P.E. Teacher Description (Part Time)

Trinity Episcopal Day School seeks a part-time P.E. teacher (3 or 4 days a week) for the 2026-2027 academic year who embraces the whole-child educational philosophy. Trinity P.E. is focused on skills building at age-appropriate levels across a variety of sports. Teaching positions are ten-month, full-time positions with an annual renewal.

General Duties

- Plan and implement a developmentally appropriate PE curriculum focused on motor skills, coordination, teamwork, and overall physical fitness.
- Incorporate a variety of physical activities, games, and skill-building exercises to engage all students.
- Facilitate the school's archery program in accordance with safety protocols and guidelines (certification or training provided if needed).
- Assess student progress in physical education and provide feedback to students, parents, and staff.
- Ensure a safe and inclusive environment for all students during PE classes.
- Collaborate with classroom teachers and school staff to support student wellness and school-wide events.
- Maintain equipment and take inventory of PE and supplies.
- Participate in professional development as needed.

Qualifications and Skills

- Bachelor's degree in Physical Education, Kinesiology, or related field (or working toward certification).
- Experience teaching or working with children in a physical activity or educational setting.
- Archery instruction experience or willingness to complete training
- Strong classroom management and communication skills.
- A passion for teaching and promoting lifelong physical activity and health.
- An ability to communicate clearly and with appropriate empathy to students, parents, and colleagues.
